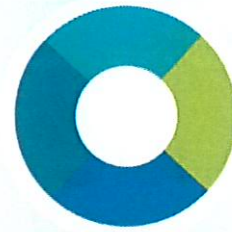

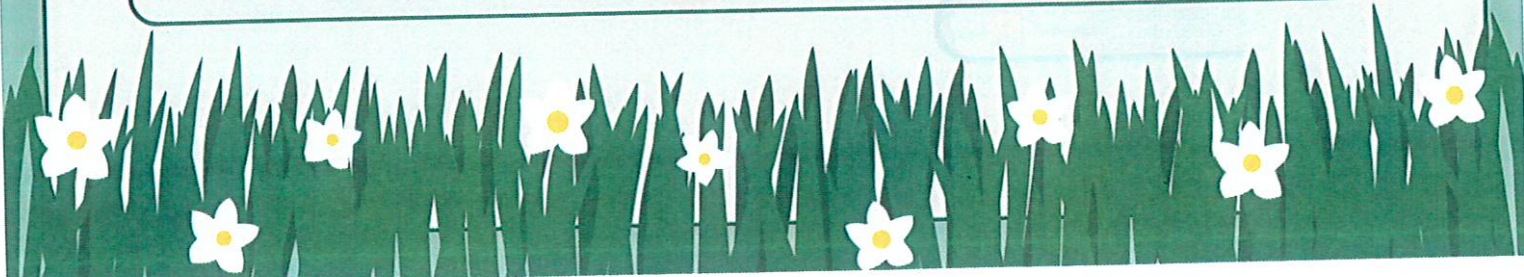
PROF IAN CHRISTIE RECOMMENDS

- One of the most important books I've ever read - "An Indispensable Guide to Thinking Clearly About the World" BILL GATES

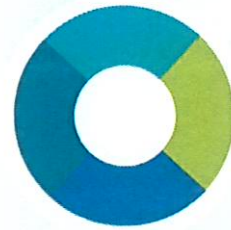
